

Security Camera Grant Program Guidelines

- 1. MSM will provide up to \$1500 (available with a 50/50 match). To be eligible for the grant the Security Review Committee or the Executive Director must determine that the camera installation will benefit not only the property/business owner, but also the surrounding public space.
- 2. Recordings must be made available to the Morgantown City Police Department via internet (only if there is a reported incident or crime). These recordings will need to be saved on a (DVR System) up to 5 business days.
- 3. It is also recommended that you provide one camera per 30 feet to be approved for these grant dollars. An onsite visit is available for anyone considering this grant, to assure grant approval.

Recommended features for Security System

- ◆ DVR (digital video recording)
- 480 line in color minimum
- 2 LUX maximum
- Shock resistant cameras
- Surveillance area of 30 feet per camera
